Waterise will design, install and operate subsea reverse osmosis (RO) desalination plants, which utilise hydrostatic pressure to push the seawater through membranes creating permeate water which will be pumped to the shore by the Torishima Pumps from the Waterise subsea desalination module. The Waterise system has a number of key advantages over conventional terrestrial RO plants such as a 40% reduction on Specific Energy Consumption (SEC) and requires 80% less land. As the system is located at 500m sea depth the water entering the system's membranes is considerably cleaner and is a constant temperature, therefore it does not require the high levels of chemical treatment necessary on conventional plants.

'The key thing about the Waterise system is they are utilising proven RO technology, there is nothing new about the process, it's just installed subsea' says Gerry Ashe, Torishima's Deputy CEO.
